HUTKA SHINES IN TIFFIN CARNIVAL ON SATURDAY

Cross-Country– In a field of almost 200 strong Division I girl harriers, Senior Lauren Hutka took an amazing 13th place finish in a time of 20:38, a personal best for her. Lauren was followed by Sophomore Maddie Duncan, who finished 40th with a time of 21:20. The girls' varsity was rounded out by Michelle Carandang, Gabi Patarini, Paige Tesmer, and Anna Jaskowiak. The girls placed 15th out of 28 teams overall, which is a huge improvement from last year.

The boys' were led by Junior Jash Ayers with a time of 18:20, followed by Zach Siefker with 18:30, Conrad Doehne 18:33, and Mike Taylor 18:48. The boys had a tight lead pack which helped them improve on their overall standings from last year. They boys finished 23 out of 28 teams. The Cross-Country team has the week off this week as they will look to peak for the year end tournaments in October.

Boys' Soccer – The Boys Soccer team battled to draws of 2-2 and 1-1 last week against Firelands and Elyria. The Middies took a 2-0 lead on the Falcons, but gave up late goals in the WSC contest to allow Firelands to earn the tie. Saturday, the Middies and Falcons played to a rugged 1-1 tie, as each team used strong defense to play to the draw. The Boys' Soccer team moved their record to 1-2-2 and 0-1-1 in the WSC as they take on Vermilion and Columbia this week.

Volleyball – Midview hammered Vermilion in 3 games last Tuesday sweeping the match by a count of 25-17, 25-18, 25-22. Leading scorers for the Middies were: Danielle Herwig 13/15 hitting with 10 kills. Angela Bayus went 11/12 serving with 1 ace, also 89/89 setting with 35 assists. Arrianna Cumberledge led the team with 20 digs and Brittany Leininger had 3 blocks. Last Thursday, the Middies dropped a five-set thriller to Rocky River, 20-25, 25-18, 25-10, 17-25 and 15-12. Leading scores for the Middies were Arrianna Cumberledge had 22 digs, Angela Bayus went 98/100 setting with 29 assists, and 12/12 serving with 5 aces. Brittany Leininger led with 6 kill blocks and 15/21 hitting with 9 kills. Danielle Herwig went 15/18 with 9 kills. The Middies move their overall record 2-3, 2-2 WSC as they have a busy week upcoming with matches against Avon and Fairview, and then traveling to Westlake for the Demon Quad on Saturday.

Golf – The Golf team fell into a distant third place this week as they went 1-3 in WSC play, dropping a tri-match to Fairview and Rocky River at Big Met, and then returning home to split a tri-match with league leading Firelands and North Ridgeville. Senior Louis Elbert continues to lead the WSC in scoring as he looks to repeat as an all-WSC performer this season. The Middies return to action this week, looking toward the WSC Championships next week at Eagle Creek in Norwalk.

Football – The Middies dropped a heartbraking 28-27 contest at Buckeye last Friday. The Middies took a 21-7 lead into the locker room at halftime, led by scores from Josiah Holt, Zach Albright, and Brett Whitesel. The Bucks defense stiffened in the second half as they held the Middies scoreless for the third quarter and climbed back into the game with two scores, the second coming with just under 7 minutes to play to tie the game at 21-21. Midview answered the Buckeyes momentum with Whitesel's second TD throw of the game, a nifty screen to Holt for 79 yards, as the Middies regained the lead at 27-21 with just under 5 minutes remaining. The Bucks came back with an efficient 60 yard drive in 1:48 as QB Mike Kelly capped off the drive with a 30 yd TD scamper. Buckeye added the extra-point to take a 28-27 lead. Midview drove the ball to the Buckeye 25 yard line, but Whitesel was sacked on a 4th and 8 as time expired, giving the Bucks the exciting one point victory. The Middies, now 1-2, enter WSC play this week as they travel to Vermilion to renew the rivalry with the Sailors. Whitesel was outstanding again Friday, throwing for 192 yards and 2 TD's on 13 of 16 passing. He also added 57 yards rushing on 18 carries. Holt had a combined 134 yards on 55 yards rushing and 79 receiving, while Albright added 6 catches for 63 yards.

Girls Tennis – The Girls Tennis dropped matches by 5-0 counts to Rocky River and Avon this week in the WSC. The girls’ return to WSC action this week against Fairview and North Ridgeville

Girls Soccer – The Girls’ Soccer team dropped to 0-4-1 as they lost a tight 2-1 contest at Firelands last Wednesday. The Middies, now 0-2 in the WSC, host Keystone and Vermilion this week as they look for their first win of the year.
