The Lorain County Schools Crisis Counseling Team (LCSCCT) will be celebrating its 10th anniversary on March 13th, 2009 during their winter in-service at the House of Praise in Lorain. Each school year, the Team--which originated in Midview--attends to students affected by traumatic events in school districts across the county. The severity of the crises may range from violent incidents and car accidents, to the death of a faculty member, or a terminal illness in a young classmate.
