MIDDIE SPORTS REVIEW (August 31, 2009)

FOOTBALL KICKS-OFF SEASON WITH SOLID WIN

Football – Zach Albright returned the opening kickoff 83 yards on Friday night, and the Middies never looked back as they routed Admiral King 35-15 in the season opener at George Daniel Field. Senior running back Josiah Holt added two scores, as Albright added another tally, and linemen Alex Dutton concluded the scoring as he fell on a King fumble for the Middies final tally of the night. Senior quarterback Brett Whitesel was solid under center, rushing for 53 yards and throwing for 126 yards on 6 of 14 passing. The Middies opportunistic defense turned King over three times, and stopped turned them away in the first quarter from a first-an- goal situation inside the five. The Middies limited the Admirals to 74 yards on the ground in building a 21-2 halftime lead. The Middies open the 2009 home season Friday night against Amherst, game time is 7:30 pm.

Boys' Soccer – Using two goals from junior Patrick Geysler, the Midview Middies opened the season with a solid 2-0 win over Keystone last Wednesday. The Middies dominated play from the beginning, and saw several early scoring chances go off the post and cross-bar before Geysler broke the ice with his first goal. The Middies received strong midfield performances in dominating the ball for most of the action. The Middies travel to Elyria Catholic on Monday before opening WSC play against perennial contender Bay on Wednesday night in Adelsberg Stadium.

Golf – The Middle Golf team finished second in the Ranger Invitational at Avon Oaks last week, and Senior Louis Elbert finished third in the prestigious event which concluded the non-conference part of the schedule. The Middies open WSC play this week as they look to defend their three consecutive WSC titles.

Girls Tennis – The Girls Tennis dropped a match to Berea 4-1 last week. The Middies open WSC play this week with matches against Bay and Vermilion.

Cross-Country– The Middle Harriers opened up the season in the WSC Preview at Bay Village on Saturday. Senior Lauren Hutka was strong for the girls, as she finished ninth with a time of 21:38 on the 5K course, which was under 30 seconds off a top-5 finish. Maddie Duncan finished 15th for the girls and Jash Ayers had a 25th place for the Boys. Both teams will be at LCCC this weekend for the Avon Lake Early Bird Classic.

Girls Soccer – The Girls' Soccer team opened the season at 0-1-1 last week as they dropped a 5-3 decision to Parma, and then came back 2 days later to play host Lutheran West to a 1-1 tie. Against Parma, freshman Kayla Hirschfelder and junior Paige Stefancin tallied for the Middies, who fought hard, but could not come all the way back from an early 3-0 deficit. The Middies battled back against the Longhorns on Thursday, as Ann Turner tallied the tying goal, and saw her bid for the win hit the post with just over 3 minutes to play. The Middies travel to Bay on Wednesday to take on the Rockets.

Volleyball – The Middies open the season this evening against Brunswick and then open WSC play with Bay and Firelands this week. All three matches are at here at Kubuski gymnasium.
