

MIDVIEW ATHLETIC WINTER SPECTATOR & TICKETING GUIDELINES

Statement of Understanding:

- Following the ODH order issued on *August 19* and the OHSAA Update issued on October 15, the Midview Athletic Department will follow the protocols below regarding spectator attendance and ticketing guidelines for the Winter of 2020. The guidelines below are meant to provide every student-athlete the ability to have their immediate family be able to watch them compete this fall. With a variety of facilities in our league, there are bound to be variances in availability of tickets based on the venue.
- Everyone must Self-Symptom Check BEFORE Arrival. Have COVID-19 Symptoms? Stay Home!
- Masks must be worn at ALL TIMES and cover both nose and mouth while inside the School.
- Households must sit together and Socially Distance on one of the marked spots in the bleachers.
- Seating pods will be marked off in groups of two (2) to allow for social distancing.

- Midview Athletics will utilize HomeTown Ticketing for home events and will follow the host school's directive for away contests. Tickets will be purchased via <http://www.midviewk12.org/Tickets.aspx>

MHS Basketball:

- All tickets for high school basketball will be sold in a pre-sale format (there will be no sale of tickets at gates)
- Varsity tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$6 plus processing fees. Freshmen and Junior Varsity tickets will each be \$3 plus processing fees.
- Only those spectators with purchased tickets will be allowed to enter.
- Fans with Freshmen Tickets must leave immediately following the Freshmen Game; JV fans will not be able to enter until the Freshmen game is over and must leave immediately following their game; Varsity fans will not be able to enter until the JV game has concluded. Exceptions apply for those with a student-athlete participating in multiple games that day.
- Fans MUST enter through the Kubuski Lobby and Exit will be through the Kubuski Doors on the Stage side of the facility. NO RE-ENTRY without a new ticket. NO ENTRY through the back of the school (Door 14).
- Kubuski Gym fixed seating capacity is 800 for this season. Therefore, we are limited to 15% (120 spectators)
- The home school will allocate two (2) tickets for every student-athlete (basketball player, cheerleader and Skipper) & coach.
- The visiting school will allocate two (2) tickets for every student-athlete (basketball player and cheerleader) & coach.
- Fans will be asked to sit across from their team's bench rather than intermingle throughout the whole side of the stands.
- No Congregating before or after the game in the K-Gym or K-Gym Lobby.
- **CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD AT BOYS BASKETBALL GAMES, CURRENTLY NOT AT GIRLS BASKETBALL GAMES.**

MHS Wrestling:

- All tickets for high school wrestling will be sold in a pre-sale format (there will be no sale of tickets at gates)
- Tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$6 plus processing fees
- Only those spectators with purchased tickets will be allowed to enter.
- Entrance will be through the Kubuski Lobby and Exit will be through the Kubuski Doors on the Stage side of the facility. NO RE-ENTRY without a new ticket.
- Kubuski Gym fixed seating capacity is 800 for this season. Therefore, we are limited to 15% (120 spectators)
- The home school will allocate two (2) tickets for every student-athlete & coach.
- The visiting school will allocate two (2) tickets for every student-athlete & coach.
- Seating pods will be marked off in groups of 2 to allow for social distancing.
- No Congregating before or after the match in the K-Gym or K-Gym Lobby.
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD AT WRESTLING MATCHES**

MHS Bowling:

- The North Shore Bowling Conference is limiting spectator attendance to one (1) family member per bowler at most locations.
- Due to capacity limits, there will be No Spectators allowed at Strikeout Lanes or Park Lanes and limited spectators at Slovak Lanes.

Middle School Basketball:

- All tickets for basketball will be sold in a pre-sale format (there will be no sale of tickets at gates)
- Middle School tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$3 plus processing fees.
- Only those spectators with purchased tickets will be allowed to enter.
- The home school will allocate two (2) tickets for every athlete (maximum 15) & coach.
- The visiting school will allocate two (2) tickets for every athlete (maximum 15) & coach.
- We will be requiring parents of seventh graders to leave following their game so we can let the eighth-grade parents enter.
- Seating pods will be marked off in groups of 2 to allow for social distancing.
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD AT BASKETBALL GAMES**

Middle School Wrestling:

- All tickets for wrestling will be sold in a pre-sale format (there will be no sale of tickets at gates)
- Middle School tickets will be sold at the general admission price of \$3 plus processing fees.
- Only those spectators with purchased tickets will be allowed to enter.
- The home school will allocate one (1) ticket for every athlete (maximum 30) & coach.
- The visiting school will allocate two (1) ticket for every athlete (maximum 30) & coach.
- Seating pods will be marked off in groups of 2 to allow for social distancing.
- **NO CONCESSIONS WILL BE SOLD AT WRESTLING MATCHES**
